

Notification of Personal Information Processing for Digital Student ID Cards of I-Shou University

To the Cardholder,

The digital student ID card mentioned herein is a **personal iPass card with the cardholder's name** (hereinafter referred to as the "registered iPass card") jointly issued by I-Shou University and iPASS Corporation (hereinafter referred to as the Corp.). The registered iPass card is not only a student ID card but also an electronic stored-value card (it can be used to make small payments, pay public transportation fares, and check records on transactions). **If the registered iPass card is lost, stolen, robbed, defrauded, or possessed by a third party other than the cardholder, the cardholder may report loss and apply for a refund to the Corp.**

According to the Financial Supervisory Commission, R.O.C., if an iPass card is designed to function as an identity document, the Corp. should collect the cardholder's personal information, register the iPass card as one with the cardholder's name, and provide the cardholder with the service of reporting loss. Pursuant to Article 11 of the *Act Governing Issuance of Electronic Stored Value Cards*, the terms and conditions of the standard contract prepared by an issuer for its electronic stored value cards should comply with the Mandatory and Prohibitory Provisions To Be Included In Standard Contracts announced by the Competent Authority. Pursuant to Article 3 of the *Standard Contract Sample for Electronic Stored Value Cards*, an applicant for an electronic stored-value card with the cardholder's name should fill in an application form with his/her accurate, latest, and complete personal information, and he/she should also provide authentic documents or certificates as requested by the issuer. In order to issue the registered iPass card, the Corp. will collect the cardholder's personal information, including the name, the national ID number, the student number, the date of birth, and the serial number of the registered iPass card.

After collecting the personal information mentioned above, the Corp. should properly keep the cardholder's personal information according to the Personal Information Protection Act. **The personal information collected by the Corp. should be processed and used for the purpose of providing services related to registered iPass cards and will not be used for any other purposes.**

The cardholder may exercise the following rights with regard to his/her personal information collected by the Corp.: (1) making an inquiry of or requesting to review his/her

personal information; (2) asking for a duplicate of his/her personal information; (3) requesting the Corp. to supplement or correct his/her personal information; (4) requesting the Corp. to discontinue collecting, processing or using his/her personal information; and (5) requesting the Corp. to delete his/her personal information. The cardholder should submit a written application and supporting documents to the Corp. to exercise any of the rights mentioned above.

If this notification is not signed and sent back to the Corp. by 08 (m) 20 (d), 2017(y), it indicates that you refuse to provide personal information, and the Corp. will lock your registered iPass card. In other words, the registered iPass card cannot be used to add value, make small payments or pay public transportation fares as an electronic stored-value card does. To unlock the registered iPass card, you should provide the Corp. with personal information and the card. Moreover, NT\$20 will be charged for unlocking the card and NT\$49 for registration.
